SPEAKER MARVEL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, Senator Hefner was closing. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed no. To return the bill for the specific amendment as expressed. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 8 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion carries and the bill has been returned. Now we will move for the adoption of the bill, of the motion.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I move the adoption of the amendment as explained previously.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Okay, all in favor of the motion vote aye, all opposed vote no. It is the adoption of the Hefner amendment. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 9 nays on adoption of Senator Hefner's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Now all in favor of readvancing the bill say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is readvanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Vickers now moves to return LB 1002 to Select File for a specific amendment. The amendment is on page 1729 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Vickers.
