SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Vickers, what is the total amount of your amendment?

SENATOR VICKERS: Forty million dollars, Mr. Speaker. A total of sixty million additional with the twenty million that Senator Warner put in. I am taking out the seventy-five and the thirty-two that we put in last week.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The only reason I violate any communications priorities here now is I heard it was twenty and twenty and I just wanted to be sure. It is twenty and forty, is that right? Okay. All those in favor of the Vickers amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the Vickers motion. Have you all voted?

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President. If somebody else would vote, I wouldn't have to do it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 15 nays on adoption of Senator Vickers amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Are there any other amendments? The motion is to readvance the bill. All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The bill is readvanced.

CLERK: Yes, sir, several. Mr. President, Senator Koch now moves to amend the bill. Senator Koch wants to withdraw his amendment, Mr. President. Mr. President, Senator DeCamp, you had one to strike the Vickers amendment.

SENATOR DeCAMP: The Vickers amendment has already been struck, that was the seventy-five million. So I'd withdraw that.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kahle now moves to return the bill to Select File.

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. Speaker, members, as I stated earlier, this amendment would provide that all additional funds added to state aid above the fifty-five million we now have would be on a per pupil basis. There are those in the body that would like to put the whole amount, fifty-five included, into the per pupil basis but my amendment at the present time does not say that. I know this has been tried before. I know we have had a lot of jockeying across the
