SENATOR KELLY: All I want to say, Mr. Speaker, is that the reason that we didn't take the committee amendments on a previous bill was it ran out of time and that may happen to this bill but I certainly hope not.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is on the adoption of the committee amendments. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Do you want to vote on the committee amendments? Well, that is what we are voting on now but we can't get a vote. Senator Kelly, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR KELLY: I wanted to get your attention, Mr. Speaker, to either get one more vote or a Call of the House, one or the other.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The committee amendments are adopted. What do you wish to do with the bill?

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, I would like to move the advancement of LB 992 to E & R initial.
