

SPEAKER MARVEL: Shall the House go under Call. All those in favor of placing the House under call vote aye. Opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The House is under Call. Please record your presence. Senator Fowler, everyone is present except Senator Venditte. Mr. Sergeant at Arms, can you try and find Senator Venditte.

SENATOR CLARK PRESIDING

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Fowler, do you want to continue the roll without Venditte?

SENATOR FOWLER: Senator Vickers is excused as well?

SENATOR CLARK: Yes.

SENATOR FOWLER: Yes, go ahead.

SENATOR CLARK: Call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call started.)

SENATOR BARRETT: Mr. Chairman.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. Barrett.

SENATOR BARRETT: Was it not the order of the Speaker earlier to reverse the roll call the entire rest of the afternoon?

SENATOR CLARK: No. You did it one time.

SENATOR BARRETT: Senator Barrett voting no.

CLERK: (Continues roll call.) 27 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President on the motion to suspend the rules. Vote appears on page 1806 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR CLARK: Motion failed. LB 965 is next.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 965 was introduced by Senator John DeCamp. Read LB 965. The bill was first read on January 23rd, referred to Ag and Environment. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments, Mr. President, by the Ag and Environment Committee.
