So, I think we had better think just a little bit about that Select File, as Senator Schmit said, and 882 is one that is going to have to be looked at rather closely and there are some others that are too, there is no question about that. So, if we think that we are going to be able to expedite Select File I think that would be a sad mistake. So we had better be real cautious as to what we are voting on and what we are agreeable to commit ourselves to. I like Senator Schmit am willing to sit here until 5:00 in the morning if we have to, but I'm going to sit here till 5:00 in the morning before I move that Select File across without looking at those issues.
