SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Clark, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR CLARK: This is the only way that I could possibly support the bill. I'll certainly support Senator Chambers amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The first vote is the Chambers amendment to the DeCamp amendment. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Chambers amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion now is the adoption of the DeCamp amendment as amended by the Chambers amendment. Is there any discussion on that? All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the DeCamp amendment, Mr. President.

Mr. President, Senator Cullan had his kill motion to be withdrawn. Senator Landis had an amendment to the bill Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, this is simply a technical amendment. In the cities of Omaha and Lincoln there is presently a corrections division that handles the jails. This simply recognizes that fact and makes a reference to them so that the sections having to do with the care and maintenance of the jails with respect to county sheriffs are distinguished from those counties that have the corrections divisions. This measure was passed last year creating that mechanism and this is simply a recognition of that and an exemption from it because in fact these counties are apples and what we are doing here is an orange, if you will. It is strictly technical. I understand that Senator Chambers has been apprised of the language and I hope that you will clean up the statutes in this way and not allow for a confusing declaration in the statutes which will create some difficulty of interpretation. I hope that you will pass the amendment.
