CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted on the Nichol amendment? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 12 nays on adoption of Senator Nichol's amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: The amendment is accepted. Do you have another amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, Senator Warner now moves to amend the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Warner.

CLERK: Senator Warner wishes to withdraw, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: It is withdrawn. Is there any more amendments?

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a motion from Senator Cullan, to suspend Rule 6, Section 4, Rule 7, Section 3 and vote without debate and without further amendment on the advancement of LB 882.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, so moved.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Cullan. Do you move to suspend the rules?

SENATOR CULLAN: I did.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, how many amendments are there?

CLERK: I have two additional amendments, Senator.

SENATOR DeCAMP: One of them is Senator Warner's. Is that correct?

CLERK: No, sir. I have two from Senator Koch.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Senator Warner, what happened?

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Warner withdrew his amendment.
