SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, hearing no objections, so ordered. The kill motion is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Keyes moves to amend the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker, I move we adopt the amendments to the bill. All this does is takes the two cents a gallon gas tax out of the bill. We have 722 that is proceeding very nicely across the floor. It is on Final Reading. And then all that will be left in 361 is the transportation for senior citizens outstate Nebraska. It is already a reality in Omaha and Lincoln and so I would ask that the committee or that the Legislature reject the two cents a gallon gas tax that is in the bill and pass it on. That is all I will say. It won't take fifteen minutes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fitzgerald, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Mr. Speaker, I oppose Senator Keyes' amendment. We have worked out something else on this bill and now I thought I worked with his people and they agreed with me.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are speaking to the Keyes motion to 361. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: What, you called on me?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Your light was on.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I was just going to call for the question when the people got tired of talking. Are they tired?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, not yet.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well, I will let them talk some more.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Labeledz, do you wish to speak to the motion? Senator Lamb. This is the Keyes motion to 361.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members, a question of Senator Keyes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, do you yield?
