CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators are in their seats and they are in the process of recording their presence and the Clerk is authorized to take call in votes. And how many do we have excused, same group? Who? Senator Koch and Senator Keyes, Senator Fowler, Senator Schmit, Senator Rumery, Senator Lamb, Senator Haberman, Senator Newell, Senator Simon, Senator Maresh. I am sorry, that is Senator Marsh. Senator Nichol. Senator Fowler, will you record your presence, please? Senator Nichol. Ray, will you see if you can find Senator Nichol, please? I have already authorized call ins. The Clerk is authorized to take call in votes.

CLERK: Senator Vickers voting no.

SENATOR MARESH: Let's have a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to go ahead and call roll?

SENATOR MARESH: Read the motion please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Mr. Clerk, do you want to read the motion?

CLERK: Mr. President, the Maresh amendment reads as follows: To amend LB 361 by increasing the gas tax by 3 cents to 13½ cents.

Roll call vote taken. (See page 1845, Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All legislators are to be in their seats. We have got a Call of the House. I am going to hold up proceedings until all are in their seats.

CLERK: Roll call continued. 18 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Are we ready for the next bill?

CLERK: No. Mr. President, Senator Fitzgerald moves to indefinitely postpone LB 361. That would lay the bill over, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fitzgerald, do you want to suspend the rules?

SENATOR FITZGERALD: No.
