SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, you asked for a roll call vote? Call the roll. The motion is the suspension of the rules.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 1850, Legislative Journal.) 17 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to suspend the rules.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost.

CLERK: Senator Simon moves to indefinitely postpone the bill, Mr. President. That would lay it over pursuant to our rules.

SENATOR SIMON: I move to suspend the rules.

SPEAKER MARVEL: What is the motion?

SENATOR SIMON: Suspend the rules to take up the kill motion today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House is to suspend the rules to indefinitely postpone 954A, is that right?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, all in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote. No, I am sorry. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Do you wish to suspend the rules?

SENATOR SIMON: That takes thirty votes, right, Mr. President?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 4 nays on the motion to suspend the rules to take up the kill motion, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to indefinitely postpone 954A. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays to indefinitely postpone 954A, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The bill is indefinitely postponed.

CLERK: Yes, sir, if you give me just a second.
