SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President and colleagues, this just isn't the way to do it and we all know it. You just can't move this legislation across without looking at it and without debating it. There is more to it than knowing how we are going to vote on each individual measure. There is such a thing as legislative intent which is very important in case any provision or any part of this legislation is challenged by the courts. We get into this mess every year and we all know why and that is beside the point but then we, or some of us or some special interest has one measure that they have an overriding interest in and the rest of the state be damned. That one item is all we care about and we are going to do anything to get that one item across, regardless of what else we bring along with it, and that was debated an hour and a half on this floor with the committee hearing and so this is a poor way to do it and we all know that it is a poor way to do it. Now if you want to sit here till midnight and if you want to roll the clock back or anything like that, that is fine and I am willing to do it. I don't need to be out of here at six. I don't need to be out of here at eight. I don't need to be out of here at nine-thirty. I will stay here and I will debate the issues and I will listen to the debate on the issues, but to say and close off debate and gag this Legislature would be an unforgiveable thing. Senator Beutler is absolutely right, and you know what? We have people that like to create this kind of a situation because they know we get into this kind of a bind and they delay and stall all through the session to throw all of these issues into this type of thing knowing that there is going to be a panic, a stampede, to put it all across. It never has been right and it is not right now and it is not fair to the people of the State of Nebraska to do it.
