SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. We now proceed to Select File and take up LB 643. I assume that the Legislature will take a minimum of time even if there is no motion before us. LB 643, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a series of amendments on LB 643. The first item we need to discuss is...there are E & R amendments, Mr. President, to the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely, E & R amendments to LB 643.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move those E & R amendments to LB 643.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Sieck has a motion to strike section 5. I understand he...that one was printed on 1789, Senator. I have got a note that you want to withdraw.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Sieck, you ask unanimous consent to withdraw the amendment?

SENATOR SIECK: Yes, if I can get the substitute motion I had on that bill. It does.....you object.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to move?

SENATOR SIECK: Well, I am going to move for the bill if he objects.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you going to move for the amendment?

SENATOR SIECK: I move for the amendment, yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to substitute the amendment.

SENATOR SIECK: Right. Okay, do you want me to explain the amendment? Okay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Sieck. The Clerk will read the motion again so we know where we are.

CLERK: Well, did Senator.....you want to withdraw, Senator... you ask unanimous consent to withdraw....
