LB 643, 824

SENATOR SIECK: Mr. President and members of the body, I move that we advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to advance the bill to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 824.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 824, there are E & R amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 824.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The E & R amendments to 824. All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch now moves to amend the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Would you read the amendment, please, Pat.

CLERK: It is on page 1766, Senator. Would you like me to read it?

SENATOR KOCH: Please.

CLERK: Read Koch amendment as found on page 1766 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, this amendment is a technical amendment and that is all it is. Presently we are operating under a law that calls for millages on valuations and all this does is correlates 824 with LB 599 and I think Senator Warner will confirm this in case there is some doubters and we are putting it into dollars and cents on valuation rather than leaving the mill levy as it would be and so it is merely a harmonization of existing law. I ask for adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Koch amendment to LB 824. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment.
