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SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, in deference to Senator Hoagland to show I am a completely sporting fellow, he wanted to try one more amendment, is that correct, even though there are eight jillion more but I would agree to let him try whatever amendment he wants in advance of this. It takes thirty either way. Senator Hoagland, is that a sporting proposition? Is that what you want to try? All I am saying is tactically I anticipated there would be a filibuster or I thought there might. I put this up a long time ago in anticipation of that. Tactically I am entitled to vote to move the bill. I would agree to allow you to try any one thing before this if that is acceptable. What? Do what? Okay, Senator Hoagland says to go ahead and try the motion. I move as it states to advance the bill without further amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You are talking about 820 now?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is that the rules be suspended so that we can take...what is the rest of the motion, Pat? Rules suspended what?

CLERK: Vote is on suspending Rule 6, Section 5, Rule 7, Section 3 and vote without further debate or further amendment on the advancement of LB 820.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we are going to vote on it now then. All those in favor of the DeCamp, we have to suspend the rules? Okay, what is the trouble?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, they want to try the one amendment they say is agreed upon. Fine by me. I just want to have that motion there to stop the other four hundred.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. What is the next amendment?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Sam, you have got one.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hoagland, you have amendments ahead of his. He wants to withdraw. Senator Beutler and Senator...there is a Beutler amendment ahead of that. Do you want to withdraw it, Senator? I now have...I think there was a Chambers motion to indefinitely postpone, Mr. President. Mr. President, Senator Chambers' motion is to indefinitely postpone the bill and that would lay it over.
