SENATOR CLARK: The amendment is adopted. Next motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have got nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator DeCamp moves that 820 be advanced. All those in favor say aye, all those opposed. The bill is advanced. LB 939.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 939, there are E & R amendments. Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 939.

SENATOR CLARK: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, all those opposed. The amendments are adopted. Do you have anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, Senator Lamb moves to amend the bill. The Lamb amendment is on page 1649.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: I will withdraw that.

SENATOR CLARK: It is withdrawn. Anything further?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, Senator Schmit moves to amend the bill. The amendment is on 1274, Senator.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I would request unanimous consent to withdraw that amendment. I do have another one I would like to offer you.

SENATOR CLARK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Murphy moves to amend the bill. The Murphy amendment is on page 1722, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Murphy.

CLERK: Senator, you have two. Are you going to take the one that is labeled as #1?
