CLERK: 34 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, debate is ceased. The motion is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to the DeCamp amendment. Are you ready for that vote? All those in favor of the Beutler amendment to the DeCamp amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Senator DeCamp? The motion is. . . this is the Beutler amendment. All those. . . okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 25 nays Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Now we are voting on the DeCamp amendment. Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: I would like to get a clarification. We just had the Hoagland amendment, which is actually the Hoagland-Newell, is that correct? Is that the only one that is on there? I would like to add one more amendment. Does the DeCamp amendment not only move bills that have no amendments pending but also bills with amendments pending?

CLERK: Yes sir.

SENATOR NEWELL: Okay, and it also specifies which amendments?

CLERK: Yes sir.

SENATOR NEWELL: Senator DeCamp, I have an amendment to 933 which puts Omaha into the bill. Now Omaha doesn't want in the bill, but, if they. . . they are going to be in a lot of trouble if they are not in the bill. I would like to ask you to add that to the bill.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I apologize. I understood that. I thought that I had put it up there. That is the one amendment that needs to be in there because it does clarify the situation for Omaha. They have as many problems on bonds or whatever the blazes it is as anybody so, I do apologize, I ask unanimous consent that that one be included. I guess I thought that it was up there. Are you sure it isn't? Okay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, are. . .

SENATOR DeCAMP: Ready to close on it?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No. Senator Hefner.
