LB 283

SENATOR WESELY: I move the E & R amendments to LB 283.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried, the E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Goodrich moves to amend the bill and his amendments are on page 1735 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, members of the body, you will recall that when we advanced this bill off of Select, or General File rather over to Select I told you that I would put this amendment on on Select File. There were two or three senators that had made, that wanted to make sure we were going to do this before we advanced it rather. All this does is, it says, adds the words rather that both prior service and future service so that it is clearly understood that the cost of this bill is supposed to be borne by the police and firemen that it pertains to and that is for both prior and future service. The firemen and policemen have agreed to it. Really there is no problem to it. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the amendment to LB 283 as explained by Senator Goodrich. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Goodrich's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Do you have other amendments?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Murphy moves to indefinitely postpone the bill which would lay it over. I have a motion from Senator Schmit to suspend Rule 7, Section 3 so as to consider the kill motion today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Chair recognizes Senator Schmit. Senator Schmit, your motion is to suspend the rules and take up the motion on LB 283 today.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes Mr. President, I so move.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is the rule suspension. This is simply a motion to suspend the rules in regard to LB 283. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.
