CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 933.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker I move the E & R amendments to 933.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried, the E & R amendments area adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Newell moves to amend the bill and his amendments are on page 1741 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body this amendment would basically put Omaha under the provisions of this act. It is absolutely necessary even despite the fact that Omaha would like to make its grand stand on this issue over whether or not they have Home Rule City Charters. Now let me say this simply. The question of Home Rule City Charter deals with issues that are solely of a local issue. Interest rates are not solely of a local issue, we all know that, and I think that this is the wrong place for the City of Omaha to make its grand stand. So I would urge you to accept this amendment so that the City of Omaha and all other subdivisions in the state will be the beneficiaries legally of increased interest rates.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Newell amendment to LB 933. All those in favor of the adoption of that amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 4 nays on the adoption of the Senator Newell's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried, the amendment is adopted. Are there any other amendments?

CLERK: Yes sir, Senators Newell, Hoagland and George move to amend the bill Mr. President.
