With that I concede and urge the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the adoption of the amendment as explained by Senator Newell vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

SENATOR NEWELL: Wait a minute, wait a minute, could we have maybe a Call of the House and I would accept call in votes. Is there 25 votes on this? I wonder how about a Call of the House and I will accept call in votes. Call of the House and I will accept call in votes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A Call of the House has been requested and the Chair is . . . all those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. The Clerk is authorized to take in call in votes.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 2 nays to go under Call. Senators Koch and Fowler voting aye. Senator Koch had voted aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Clerk can record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried, the amendment is adopted. Now are we ready to advance the bill?

CLERK: Yes sir we are.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, do you want to advance the bill to E & R for Engrossment.

SENATOR NEWELL: So move.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried, the bill is advanced. We have already covered 647A, the next bill is 991.
