SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, now the motion is to advance the bill to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Yes, sir.

SENATOR STONEY: Can we get a machine vote and a record vote please?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, a machine vote and record vote have been requested. Senator Chambers, there was quite a little opportunity to debate. Do you have a point that you wish to state to the Chair?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: A chance to debate the motion. Sure, my light was on. Ask the young man sitting next to you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, clear the board.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I will let it go and I will make a motion to bring it back from Final Reading. I will do it there and debate then.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any other discussion on the bill before we put the motion? Okay, the motion is the advancement of the bill to E & R for engrossment. A machine vote and a record vote have been requested. All those in favor... excuse me. Okay, call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See pages 1870 and 1871, Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 6 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we will proceed with LB 992.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may right before 992, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that they have carefully examined and engrossed LB 283 and find the same correctly engrossed, 643, 740, 820, 865, 918, 939, and 939A. (signed) Senator Wesely, Chairman.

Mr. President on LB 992 on Select File, there are E & R amendments pending.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 992.
