SPEAKER MARVEL: LB 965

CLERK: Mr. President on LB 965 there are E & R Amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker I move the E & R amendments to 965.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carries the E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion from Senator DeCamp to suspend the rules, specifically Rule 6, Section 5, Rule 7, Section 3 and vote without further debate and without further amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I am doing this for you. In other words there are more amendments, the bill is in as perfect of form as I think that it needs to be. I think the amendments are like double the tax which has already been tried, or to kill the bill which will just take another half hour anyway. Either it has 30 votes to advance it which it is going to require or it doesn't. I am urging you to do this and just get it over with one way or the other. Does that make sense Sam?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is to suspend the rules. Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Senator DeCamp, I wonder if I could ask you a question about the content of the bill. Could you tell me if it is true if this bill in its current form would apply this tax to individuals to whom it was. . . would not be applied if this bill was not enacted?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes, that is correct. People that came in and decided that they wanted to be under the bill, right.

SENATOR CULLAN: So it expands the tax, and to whom does this bill expand the tax Senator DeCamp?

SENATOR DeCAMP: To whom?

SENATOR CULLAN: Who would be covered under this bill if it is enacted, where are you expanding it?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Those people that want to be covered that I was talking about.

SENATOR CULLAN: Who is that Senator DeCamp?
