SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Roll call. Have you all registered your presence? Record the vote.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: All legislators please take your seats and we will start Final Reading and the first bill on Final Reading is LB 615.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may before we get to that, Senator Warner offers a proposed rule change that will be referred to the Rules Committee. (See pages 1875-78 of the Journal.)

SENATOR MARVEL: Okay, the Clerk will read LB 615 on Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read LB 615 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. Those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Ray, will you go into 2102 and bring the Exec Board out so they can vote on this bill? We can't debate on Final Reading, I'm sorry. We are in the midst of taking a vote on Final Reading. Have you all voted? Okay, record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1879 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 32 ayes, 6 nays, 11 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading, LB 615A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 615A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no, 615A. A bills will take 30 votes. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1879-80 of the Journal.) 31 ayes, 7 nays, 11 not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading, LB 618.
