LB 618, 618A, 701

CLERK: (Read LB 618 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. Those in favor vote aye, opposed no, LB 618. Have you all voted? Ray, will you go after the Executive Board again, please? Have you all voted? We are voting on LB 618 and there is an A bill after this bill. The A bill takes 30 votes. Have you all voted? Okay, Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1880-81 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, 2 not voting.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. We will now read the A bill, 618A. This bill needs 30 votes.

CLERK: (Read LB 618A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with the question is, shall the bill pass, 618A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Could we have a Call of the House?

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call.

SENATOR CULLAN: I would like everyone to register their presence and as soon as everyone is here I would like a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, clear the board. Record your presence please. Senator Landis, Senator Koch, Senator George, Senator Dworak, Senator Haberman, Senator Barrett, Senator Vickers, Senator Lewis. Senator Vickers, Senator Lewis, will you please record in? Okay, are we ready...? Clerk, call the roll on LB 618A.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 1881 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 15 nays on the passage of the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK PRESIDING

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed. The Clerk will now read LB 701.

CLERK: (Read LB 701 on Final Reading.)
