CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1895 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 2 nays, 1 excused and not voting and 7 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed. The Clerk will read 818A.

CLERK: (Read LB 818A on Final Reading.)
