SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 765.

CLERK: Read LB 765.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. LB 765. Have you all voted? Record the vote. Have you all voted? Okay, now record the vote. Still has the emergency clause on. Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President, as I understand it this bill with the emergency clause would require 33 votes. Is that correct?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, as long as we are under Call, I would like a record of who is here and then a roll call vote if we don't come up with something here shortly.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Outside of Senator Marsh, Senator Goodrich, Koch, Labedz, Lewis, Nichol, Schmit, Warner.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Everybody is here.

SPEAKER MARVEL:till they arrive. Seven plus Senator Marsh is eight. Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Has Senator Wagner been excused?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No. Record the vote.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 4 nays, 5 excused and not voting 3 present and not voting. (Vote appears on pages 1913-14 of the Legislative Journal).

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 765A.

CLERK: Read LB 765A.
