SPEAKER MARVEL: Bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 346.

CLERK: Read LB 346.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 1 nay, 4 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting. (Vote appears on pages 1915-16 of the Legislative Journal).

CLERK: Read LB 741.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record the vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. 873 on Final Reading. Have you all voted? Voting on LB 873. Have you all voted? Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: We have the emergency clause, on Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes sir.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: It takes two more votes, doesn't it Senator Stoney? Two more votes? I guess it takes one more vote and we won't have to read it again without the emergency clause.
