CLERK: 44 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting. (Vote appears on page 1926 of the Legislative Journal).

SPEAKER MAVEL: The bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Now take up the A bill, LB 633A.

CLERK: Read LB 633A.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. LB 633A. Record.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 5 present and not voting. (Vote appears on page 1927 of the Legislative Journal).

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Before we go to the next bill it is my privilege to present and from Senator Chronister's district 22 fourth graders from Stanton, Nebraska, Wanda Publow the teacher, in the north balcony. CLERK: Read LB 651.

CLERK: 43 ayes, 1 nay, 2 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting. (Vote appears on page 1928 of the Legislative Journal).

CLERK: Read LB 684.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass on Final Reading. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. LB 684. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 10 nays, present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting. (Vote appears on page 1929 of the Legislative Journal).
