ASSISTANT CLERK: 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting.  
(Vote appears on pages 1940-41 of the Legislative Journal).

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading.  
The Clerk will now read LB 877A.

SENATOR LEWIS: Read LB 877A.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied  
with, the question is, shall the bill pass on Final Reading.  
LB 877A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.  
Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 39 ayes, 1 nay, 3 excused and not voting,  
5 present and not voting. (Vote appears on page 1941 of
