LB 632, 632A, 280

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of doing business I propose to sign and I do sign LR 345. Anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Not right now, no, sir.

PRESIDENT: All right, we will proceed then with Final Reading. The Sergeant at Arms will secure the Chamber for Final Reading. All members will return to their desks. All nonlegislative personnel will leave the floor, and the Legislature is on Final Reading. As soon as everybody is at their desks we will start a long list of Final Reading for the day. It's all right with you, Senator Nichol? All right. Let's go. We will commence the Final Reading on LB 632, Mr. Clerk. Proceed and may everybody get to their desks eventually.

CLERK: (Read LB 632 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 632 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1953 and 1954 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 632 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 632A.

CLERK: (Read LB 632A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 632A pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1954 and 1955 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 632A passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 280.

CLERK: (Read LB 280 on Final Reading.)
