LB 790, 790A

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, then I won't prolong it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. The Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 790.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 790 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with. the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. It's 790 on Final Reading. This bill has an emergency clause on it. Okay, record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Commenced reading the record vote as found on pages 1979 and 1980 of the Legislative Journal.)

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1979 and 1980 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, and 2 not voting.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, failing to get the necessary votes the emergency clause is stricken. You now vote on 790 without the emergency clause. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 1980 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 19 nays, 6 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed without the emergency clause. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 790....let's see, we've got 790A first, don't we?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Haberman moves to return LB 790A to Select File, purpose being to strike the enacting clause.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, let me tell you another little sleeper about this bill. Where did they get the money, and how much money? Well, they are going to take \$44,000 from the General Fund but here is the hooker. They are taking \$7,000 away from... they are taking it away from Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center. They are taking the money away from them. Now, we have sat here and said the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center is good. It is good. It's excellent. It is doing a fine job. It needs every dollar it can get. But this bill takes \$7,000 away from them and throws in another \$44,000 of tax dollars for \$51,000, and what's it for?
