ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1981 and 1982 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 36 ayes, 12 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed with emergency clause attached. Now before we go to LB 800, may I make one announcement that should be of interest to you? The Appropriations Committee has been meeting in regard to overrides. The Appropriations Committee has five recommendations at this point. There will be others later, I am told, but at this point there will be five recommendations and there is also one additional override. These will be attempted before noon...the five Appropriations and the one in regard to the lid bill. I alert you now so that you please can keep it in mind as we proceed with Final Reading. Before we proceed with LB 800, twenty-three 4th Grade students from Senator Hoagland's District, Brownell-Talbot School, and two teachers, in the north balcony. Will you raise your hands so we can see where you are? We welcome you to the Unicameral. The Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 800.

CLERK: (Read LB 800 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. LB 800 on Final Reading.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1982 and 1983 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: LB 800 is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read LB 820.

CLERK: (Read LB 820 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CLARK: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall 820 with the emergency clause attached be passed? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.
