Your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined LB 694 and find the same correctly enrolled; 740, 790, 790A, 795, 800, 820, 824, 865, 872 and 872A, all correctly enrolled.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, for point of clarification, and for the record, did I understand you to say on LB 882 that it did have the emergency clause?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CARSTEN: I believe, for the record, Mr. Speaker, we should clarify that there was not an emergency clause on LB 882 but on 882A there was. Is that not correct?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, then the Chair was in error because the worksheet shows 882 with emergency clause on and there were 34 votes I think. That's why the declaration was made.

SENATOR CARSTEN: But there was no emergency clause on the...

SPEAKER MARVEL: That's what the Clerk tells me.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Very good, and for the record I thought we should clarify that, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Thank you, sir.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Thank you. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I am about to sign and do sign LB 694, 740, 790, 790A, 795, 800, 820, 824, 865, 872, 872A.

CLERK: (Read LB 918 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with emergency clause attached? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. LB 918. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1990 and 1991
