SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me, just a minute. Senator Marsh, did you withdraw your motion? Okay. Motion is withdrawn. Okay, proceed.

CLERK: Read LB 939 on Final Reading.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. 939. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? I am going to call for the vote once more and then call to record. Have you all voted? This has the emergency clause on it. That is right. Senator Newell, is this your bill, committee bill? Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1999, Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 12 nays, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill passes with the emergency clause attached. Now the Clerk will read LB 939A.

CLERK: Final reading of LB 939A.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. 939A. Have you all voted? Record the vote. Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 1999 and 2000, Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 9 nays, 6 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed. Now the Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 954.
