

no counties. If we are going to run everything in this state from the state we don't need no counties to run this state, to be a part of this state. Let's just call it one county, one obligation. That is all we are doing. We are starting in that direction. This is the number one issue that has started it right here on this floor and what are we doing? We are doing that very act that every state is aware of, that people in these United States is feared of and we are one of the first actors in that degree, so if this is the way you want to run the state, go ahead. We will cancel out the counties and run it from here. We are not taking the lid off. These people can vote on it in the public petition, they have still got their rights. We never took that away from them, and like Falls City, we will still live with the lid down there. The school board has given me a letter stating if Falls City voted the lid they will still live with the lid. This isn't going to stop that. We are not doing that. All we are doing here is telling that we don't need no county government and we are going to run it from the state. Look what we done with the sheriffs deal. I could show you a half a dozen bills we had in the Government Committee this year taking it away from district, regional. Let's take it up here to the state. We have got to run things from the state. We don't need no county governments and this is what we are doing, and if that is the way you want to do it, vote the other way. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall you reconsider your action in overriding LB 627? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The Chair will require 30 votes for this to pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We have got everybody here so record the vote. A roll call vote has been requested on it. All right, let's have a roll call vote. Yes, proceed with the roll call.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 2009, Legislative Journal.) 30 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on the motion we reconsider.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and the matter is reconsidered. Mr. Speaker, how do you wish to proceed now at this point? It is being reconsidered. Just take a vote without any debate. It would be better decorum if everybody would be seated so we not have all this politicking going on on the floor at this time and we are going to take a vote. Is that right, Mr. Speaker?
