PRESIDENT: All right, you withdraw your motion. It is withdrawn. Senator Venditte, I think you wanted a moment for clarification. I will give that to you. Senator Venditte.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members of the Legislature, I had indicated to you earlier that the State of Indiana has recently enacted legislation. I gave you the wrong information. It was the State of Maryland who has recently enacted legislation. I gave you a ten page Attorney General's opinion from the State of Maryland and the Governor is expected to sign the bill next week.

PRESIDENT: Okay, thank you, Senator Venditte. All right, the motion is withdrawn. Is there any further motions on the desk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion withdrawn. We are ready to have Final Reading. Again, would every member of the Legislature return to your desks. We are back on Final Reading. We will make one more stab and getting to the end of the Final Reading. Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Can we get the people in please?

PRESIDENT: Yes, I think...in fact, it might be a good idea to have everybody...let's get a record again, Mr. Clerk. I think we have had people straying out so much that... Let's record our presence one more time to make sure we have everybody in. I hate to do this but it is about the only way we can do it. A lot of people have taken off, so very quickly let's see if we can record our presence and get on with the reading of this bill. The only one who is excused is Senator Lewis, so everyone else ought to be here. We can just start down this side, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Stoney, Senator Marsh, Senator Hoagland, Senator Vickers, Senator Simon, Senator Pirsch, Senator Kremer, Senator DeCamp, Senator Lamb, Senator Maresh, Senator Schmit. Senator Simon, do you have a green light on there? Would you push it, the green button? Senator Hoagland, I see you have a red one too. Senator Pirsch, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Maresh, Senator Lamb and Senator DeCamp. All right, if the Sergeant at Arms would find those folks I think we would save time and proceed with the reading on Final Reading of LB 991, Mr. Clerk. Proceed with the Final Reading.
