SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I am about to sign and do sign LB 1004 and LB 993. On the back of your agenda there is a series of resolutions. We are not going to take up Item #7 today but we will start with Item #8.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 198.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, in the interest of saving time so that we can sine die by six, I will withdraw that resolution.

SPEAKER MARVEL: No objections? So ordered. LR 226.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 226 by Senators Landis, DeCamp, Keyes, Johnson, Labeledz. Senator DeCamp's name has been withdrawn, Mr. President, as cointroducer.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, LR 327, Senator Nichol.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 327 introduced by Senators Nichol and Pirsch found on page 1481. Senator Nichol.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol.

CLERK: Do you want me to read it, Senator? (Read.)

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, I urge the adoption of this resolution. These elderly people have done a great good for others and I move for the adoption of the resolution.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of LR 327 as explained by Senator Nichol. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.
