those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on LR 328. Has everybody voted who wants to vote? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of LR 328, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and LR 328 is adopted. LR 329.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 329 by Senator Burrows on page 1497. Read.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Burrows.

SENATOR BURROWS: Mr. Chairman, members of the body, this urges that the President, the Congress and the Federal Reserve Board move to reduce interest rates. I think the effects are becoming very evident with the homebuilding industry taking the losses it is and the unemployment rates raising across the nation, industries closing down, that it is time they move and take other actions to control inflation and I urge the body to adopt this resolution. I think we are in a crisis right now. I don't think it is a long time we have to wait for some action here or I think we will be in a recession that is very difficult if not next to impossible to turn around. I move the adoption of the resolution.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the adoption of LR 329 as explained by Senator Burrows vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of LR 329, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried and LR 329 is adopted. LR 330.

CLERK: LR 330 by Senator Landis is found on page 1499. Read.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this resolution commends the Federal Mediation Conciliation Service for providing free of charge mediators in a series of industrial disputes around Nebraska the last year. I bring this to your attention because it is evidence of the fact that 444 is working, that the idea of mediation as an appropriate mechanism for the settlement of industrial disputes has taken hold and we wish not only to congratulate and thank past mediators but that we wish to commend this
