LR 332, 333, 334

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the adoption of the resolution vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of LR 332, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Now we go to LR 333.

CLERK: LR 333 by Senator Wesely on page 1632. Read.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.
