LB 336, 337

Wednesday, April 23rd, set aside as Secretary Day. I ask that you join me in voting for the adoption of this resolution. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of LR 336. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the resolution, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The resolution is adopted. We now go to LR 337.

CLERK: LR 337 on page 1723 by Senator Powers. Read.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Powers.

SENATOR POWERS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this resolution recognizes the contribution of the National Park Service. It is a request that the government reconsider relocating them which takes 130 jobs out of downtown Omaha and I urge the adoption of this resolution.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: A question of Senator Powers if he would yield.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Powers.

SENATOR POWERS: Yes, Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Senator Powers, we have two very powerful Democratic Senators and I understand they have very good rapport with the President so I have no fear. I doubt that they will move them. With the responsibility of Senator Zorinsky and Exon, they can keep them there where they belong.

SENATOR POWERS: I hope you are right, Senator Koch, but it looks rather bleak right now and it means 130 jobs moving out of Omaha and four million dollars worth of impact money in Omaha and I am requesting that the government reconsider relocating this agency. I move the adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of LR 337 as explained by Senator Powers. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.
