SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Haberman. The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. Debate has ceased and Senator Kremer, yes, sorry.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I have no closing. I have tried to give you a legitimate reason why we ought to support this. I think Senator Vickers added something that I really meant to, the Governor all the way through has supported the idea. In fact he wanted a one cent cigarette tax that we did not get and I think we are being real reasonable. We need a lot more than this. We are at least keeping that which was brought to us by the Appropriations Committee. Again I urge your vote to keep that money for the Development Fund that we are going to need to save Nebraska water.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the override for \$300,000, yes, okay. Now let me get my wits about me and then we will start. The screaming in the back threw me for a minute. The motion is, first of all, reconsideration. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Senator Kremer. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 20 nays on the motion to reconsider the vote on line item override, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Now we have a motion on 765A.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb moves that LB 765 become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, as you may remember, LB 765 is a bill which would allow the hundred percent funding of the preschool handicapped programs through the State Department of Education and it will be using all federal funds. Those federal funds are
