CLERK: Mr. President, LR 348 introduced by Senator Powers.
Read. (See pages 2028 and 2029, Legislative Journal.)
Mr. President, the rules need to be suspended in order to
take up LR 348 today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the suspension of the rules.
All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the
vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to suspend the rules,
Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The rules are suspended.
The motion is the adoption of the Powers resolution resulted
