predecessors established and they were policies that they found served the citizens of this state well. When I first first began to think not knowing if Senator Marvel would serve again was really back following the 1979 Session, and as things have developed he has indicated a willingness to serve us again. In viewing whether or not a tradition of one hundred twenty-five years only once previously changed, was appropriate now, I went and asked for a copy of the remarks I had the privilege of making when Senator Marvel was elected two years ago, as I felt in my own mind to justify breaking a tradition that had only been broken once before that it really and truly needed to be something unique, and in my own mind I could only measure that uniqueness by what I had stood here and said what I expected Senator Marvel to do, and when I noticed that two years ago that I expected that I knew he would have knowledge of the rules, that I knew he had a willingness to preside in a fair and impartial manner, that he would make efforts to expedite the session but still retain the deliberative aspects of a legislative body, but most importantly to me - for I have tremendous respect for this Legislature as an institution, and I know that Senator Marvel shares that same respect and perhaps even one of a longer tradition, certainly a longer tradition as a member. So I commend to you as I said two years ago, I commend the leadership that I believe Senator Marvel can continue to provide and I know that each of us can take pride in the opportunity of selecting Senator Marvel once again to serve as the most distinguished position that we can bestow upon a fellow member of this body, the Speaker of the Nebraska Legislature, and I would urge your support for his election. Thank you.
