PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Prayer by the Chaplain.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will come to order. Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would like to be excused until he arrives, Mr. President, Senator Chambers until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Have you all registered your presence? Have you all recorded your presence? Record the presence, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Quorum being present, are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no corrections.

PRESIDENT: The Journal will stand as read. The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel. The Chair recognizes you for purpose of a motion on temporary rules.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I move that the rules in effect on the 60th legislative day of the 86th Legislature, Second Session, be adopted for today only.

PRESIDENT: The motion has been made by Speaker Marvel to adopt the rules, the previous rules on a day by day basis for this day only. Any discussion? All those in favor of that signify by voting aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of temporary rules.
