PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Prayer by Chaplain Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: I might just remind the Senators that I am currently interested in names of persons who might be able to open the Legislature with prayer from day to day and while I have been contacting a number of Lincoln clergy, I hope that every Senator will feel most free to talk with your clergy or those of your acquaintance in your own communities and I would be most happy to arrange for them at any time for their convenience or yours to have them open a session some day with prayer or several days. So any names you may care to give to me, either through your personal acquaintance or through any other means, I would be most happy to have. Shall we pray. (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will come to order and we will have roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Vickers would like to be excused until he arrives. Senator Vickers has arrived.

PRESIDENT: Have you all registered your presence? Record the presence, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Quorum being present, are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections to the Journal, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Journal stands as read. Any messages, reports or announcements? Oh, yes, we had better do that first. The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel for purpose of adopting temporary rules again for this day.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I move that the rules in effect on the sixtieth legislative day of the 86th Legislature, Second Session, be adopted for today only.

PRESIDENT: Motion made my Speaker Marvel to adopt temporary rules as we have done each day for that day only. Any discussion? All those in favor signify by voting aye and opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of temporary rules, Mr. President.
