SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. Okay, Senator Wesely, are you prepared to discuss the permanent rules?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Chair recognizes Senator

Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I move that the rules as set forth in the blue volume, which is dated January, 1981, be adopted as the Permanent Rules of the Nebraska Unicameral for the Eightyseventh Legislature, First Session. In addition, I would ask to divide the question for the following four areas: The first would contain Rule 7, Section 1, dealing with the one week recess period. The second division would include Rule 3, Section 11, dealing with adoption of committee procedural rules. The third division would include Rule 5, Section 5, dealing with limitations on the number of committee bills allowed for introduction. The last section would include all remaining rules as shown in the blue volume of the rules.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler, you have additional amendments...it is the Chair's understanding that you agree to pass over your items until we take up these three items. Is that correct?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I would request that I be allowed to pass over the three until the three amendments which I understand are forthcoming dealing with the first three divisions of the question have been discussed. But I do wish to have it understood that it is for those three amendments only.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I find that agreeable. Shall we just proceed then with the first?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes.

SENATOR WESELY: Again the...excuse me. The first division includes the question of the one week recess which we adopted during the 1980 Legislative Session which called for a week recess following the ten day bill limitation period which we are now into the fourth day of. We do have an amendment up there to that section which I think should be introduced at this time.
