SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the Wesely amendment. You have heard it read. All those in favor of the Wesely amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. This is the final adoption of the rules. Have you all voted? Senator Wesely, what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR WESELY: How many members are absent? We need 25 votes to adopt this division of the rules.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Seven excused. Senator DeCamp, your light is on.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I guess it is in the midst of a vote but as I understand is this the total package of rules or what?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely, do you want to repeat your amendment?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, at this point we have adopted three specific sections of the rules as the permanent rules of the Legislature, included is the question of the bill limitations. That has already been adopted as a permanent rule of the Legislature. We have left everything but those three specific sections which we already adopted. All the rest of the rules is what we are voting on now. We need these to complete the rules and to move ahead with the permanent rules.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, the Chair will call for the vote once more. That's all the Chair can do.

SENATOR WESELY: I guess I will ask for a Call of the House. I think that people understand the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question before the House is, shall the House go under Call? Okay, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of that vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President, to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats, record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Dworak, do you want to record your presence, please. Senator Maresh, will you please record your presence. Senator Haberman. The Clerk is about to proceed with the
