

CLERK: 31 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill, LB 82.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 82 is offered by Senator Harold Sieck. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 12. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee, was advanced to General File. I have no amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Sieck.

SENATOR SIECK: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, the City of York needs to build a new street...York armory and we need an easement from Adjutant General, that is, has control of the armory. He has agreed to grant this but in order to do this we have to go through the legislative process so what I am doing is asking for an easement for the City of York to build a highway by the armory and I ask for the adoption of this bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I just rise in support of this bill. The Miscellaneous Subjects Committee heard the bill and we feel the need is great. I believe the mayor of York presented his side to it and what this does, it grants an easement to the City of York so that they can build this street that is badly needed alongside the armory and I would urge your support for this bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Sieck, just a question if I may. I'm sure this is a good bill but I would just be interested in what the deficiencies are in the present law that prohibits the Adjutant General from having the kind of flexibility that is needed in this case and I am sure will be needed from time to time in other cases in other cities. I guess I am interested in why the bill is so narrowly drafted and why it doesn't perhaps deal with the problem of giving a broader authority to the Adjutant General if he does not have that kind of authority to deal with specific situations such as the present one.

SENATOR SIECK: Senator Beutler, I thought of the same thing. I thought it is kind of ridiculous to come here every time we need to do something which I did last year
