PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? A motion on the desk, I believe, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler moves to amend the bill. (Read Beutler amendment found on page 485, Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, very quickly, this is a small technical amendment which has Senator Vickers' approval. The notice requirement in the bill says that the notice has to be published three consecutive weeks in a legal newspaper, published, et cetera, et cetera. I am putting in published once each week for three consecutive weeks because it is not Senator Vickers' intent, for example, if you have a daily paper that you publish it twenty-one times. So this just clarifies that we are doing it once each week for three consecutive weeks which is the general provision with regard to notices on a lot of items in our law. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Vickers on speaking to the Beutler amendment.

SENATOR VICKERS: Yes, Mr. President, members, I thoroughly agree with Senator Beutler in this amendment. It is a very good amendment and it does clarify, as Senator Beutler indicated, that exactly what we are talking about. I might also point out for the body's general information that the rest of the language stricken, from my observation, at least, I think most all those small cities and villages are well aware of what newspaper is published in their area and that stricken language seemed to be very unnecessary. I would urge the body's adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Beutler amendment? Senator Beutler, anything further on your amendment? The question then is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to LB 33. All those in favor signify by voting aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The Beutler amendment is adopted. Senator Vickers, anything further on LB 33?

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, I'd just move that LB 33 be
