SENATOR CLARK: Is there any further debate? Senator Rumery, do you want to close?

SENATOR RUMERY: I would just urge you to support this bill and pass it on to E & R Initial. We think it is a step in the right direction. We think it is worthy of consideration by the Legislature.

SENATOR CLARK: The question is the advancement of LB 67. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion carries. The bill is advanced. We will now take up LB 77 by Senator Goodrich.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 77 offered by Senator Goodrich. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 9. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee.

SENATOR CLARK: Who wants to handle the committee amendments? Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I move for the adoption of the committee amendments. It is a very simple amendment. It just adds the emergency clause. The committee members felt that we should have the emergency clause because some cities have adopted the 1981 National Code and this way if we can get this through well then we could go ahead and our State Code would be the same as the National Code. Therefore, I would urge the adoption of this committee amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any discussion on the committee amendments? All those in favor of the committee amendments vote aye. All those opposed vote may.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted on the committee amendments? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 mays on adoption of the committee amend-ments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich on the bill.
