LB 65, 121

CLERK: 44 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carried and LB 65 is returned to Select File for the purposes of the specific amendment. Do we have the amendment? We just as well proceed with it right now. We have done this in the past and it is far more expeditious if we do it right now.

SENATOR NICHOL: That is fine with me. I just thought it had to lay over a day.

PRESIDENT: No, it does not have to lay over a day.

SENATOR NICHOL: I move for the...

PRESIDENT: A motion to adopt the amendment, the corrective amendment. Any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the corrective amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Nichol's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and the amendment is adopted. Senator Kilgarin or Senator Nichol can do it.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I move for the advancement of LB 65 to Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: The motion by Senator Nichol is to advance LB 65 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 65 is readvanced to E & R for engrossment. Now we are ready for the final bill on Final Reading, LB 121.

CLERK: LB 121 (Read on Final Reading).

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 121 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 602, Legislative Journal.) 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 121 passes and that will conclude Final Reading today. Do you have some matters to read in? You may proceed.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Education gives notice of hearing for Monday, March 16. (Signed) Senator Koch, Chair.
